Mark J. Weinstein has an extensive background in both non-profit and for-profit management. Prior to joining the Pittsburgh Opera in 1997, Mr. Weinstein served as Vice President of Operations of National Artists Management Company, an independent Broadway theatrical producing company. During his previous 13-year tenure at New York City Opera, he advanced through a series of increasingly responsible positions to become Executive Director. Mr.

Weinstein currently serves as Chair of the AGMA Pension & Welfare Fund and as Treasurer of the Board of Directors of OPERA America. He is an advisor to UMOJA African Dance Company, a member of the Advisory Board of the Center for Nonprofit Management at Robert Morris College, and a member of Leadership Pittsburgh XVI. He is the past President of the Pittsburgh Arts Leadership Group. He serves on the board of the Greater Pittsburgh Arts Alliance and has been, over the last ten years, an on-site evaluator and panel participant for the National Endowment for the Arts. In July, 1999, he became General Director of the Pittsburgh Opera, responsible for both the business and artistic aspects of the company. He is a graduate, cum laude, of Carleton College and has an MBA degree from Harvard Graduate School of Business Administration.
